INTRODUCTION

As Saraland City Schools operates during the 2023-2024 school year, procedures are updated as needed to comply with local government health orders as well as guidance from the Alabama Department of Public Health, the Mobile County Health Department, and the Alabama State Department of Education.

RETURN TO SCHOOL PROTOCOLS

Parents, guardians, and students are asked to monitor health every evening and before school each morning.

- Individuals who test positive for COVID should follow up with their health care provider for guidance.
- Individuals who test positive for COVID via home test are advised to follow up with their health care provider. However, those who choose not to follow up with a health care provider should follow ADPH/CDC guidance.
- Individuals who have been diagnosed with COVID-19 should stay home, following the onset of symptoms or the positive test result, until symptoms subside and be 24 hours without fever or fever-reducing medications before returning to school unless otherwise advised by his/her healthcare provider.

ATTENDANCE PROTOCOLS

There are no longer “COVID” codes within Powerschool. Therefore, those who test positive for COVID will need to present a doctor’s note or parent excuse.
